PARENTAL CONSENT, RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF SCHEDULED EVENT(S)

IN CONSIDERATION of my minor child ("the Minor") being permitted to participate in any way in the EVENT(S) and/or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA(S) (defined to be any area which requires special authorization, credentials or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), I agree:

1. I know the nature of the EVENT(S) and the Minor's experience and capabilities, and believe the Minor to be qualified to participate in the Event(s). I will inspect the premises, facilities, and equipment to be used, or with which the Minor may come in contact. IF I OR THE MINOR BELIEVE ANYTHING IS UNSAFE, I WILL INSTRUCT THE MINOR TO IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE RESTRICTED AREA AND REFUSE TO PARTICIPATE FURTHER IN THE EVENT(S).
2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND and will instruct the Minor that: (a) THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT(S) ARE VERY DANGEROUS and participation in the Event(s) and/or entry into Restricted Areas involves RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by the Minor's own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Event(s), the rules of the Event(s), the condition and layout of the premises and equipment, and/or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS NOT KNOWN TO ME or that are not readily foreseeable at this time; (d) THE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES and/or damages that could result from those Risk(s) COULD BE SEVERE AND COULD PERMANENTLY CHANGE THE MINOR'S FUTURE.
3. I consent to the Minor's participation in the Event(s) and/or entry into restricted areas and HEREBY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE LOSSES, COSTS AND/OR DAMAGES FOLLOWING SUCH INJURY, DISABILITY, PARALYSIS OR DEATH, EVEN IF CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW.
4. I HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations or any subdivision thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any Restricted Area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the Event(s), premises or event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and other persons or entities who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or Event(s) and each of them, their directors, officers, agents, and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees", FROM ALL LIABILITY TO ME, THE MINOR, my and the minor's personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON ACCOUNT OF ANY INJURY TO ME OR THE MINOR, including, but not limited to, death or damages to property, CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE.
5. If, despite this release, I, the Minor, or anyone on the Minor's behalf, makes a claim against any of the "Releasees" named above, I AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from ANY LITIGATION EXPENSES, ATTORNEY FEES, LOSS, LIABILITY, DAMAGE, OR COST THAT MAY INCUR DUE TO THE CLAIM MADE AGAINST ANY OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED ABOVE, WHETHER THE CLAIM IS BASED ON THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
6. I sign this agreement on my own behalf and on behalf of the Minor.

I HAVE READ THIS PARENTAL CONSENT, RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT I GIVE UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS I AND/OR THE MINOR WOULD OTHERWISE HAVE TO RECOVER DAMAGES FOR LOSSES OCCASIONED BY THE RELEASEES' FAULT, AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY AND WITHOUT INDUCEMENT.

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF SCHEDULED EVENT(S)

I have obtained my parent's consent to participate in the above event(s). I understand that I am assuming all of the risks if I get hurt during the event(s), and I state the following:

1. Both my parents and I believe I am qualified to participate in the event(s). I will inspect the premises and equipment and if, at any time, I feel anything to be unsafe, I will immediately leave and refuse to participate further in the event(s).
2. I understand that the ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT ARE VERY DANGEROUS and INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF MY BEING SERIOUSLY INJURED OR HURT, MY BEING PARALYZED OR KILLED.
3. I know that these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the event(s), the rules of the event(s), the condition and layout of the premises and equipment, and/or the NEGLIGENCE of others, including those persons responsible for conducting the event(s).
4. I HEREBY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, EVEN IF THE RISKS ARE CREATED BY THE NEGLIGENCE of the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning organizations, or any of its subdivisions, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, rescue personnel, any persons in any restricted areas, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners, and lessees of premises used to conduct the events, premises or event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants, and any other person or entity who gives recommendations, directions, or instructions, or engages in risk evaluation, loss control activities or sales regarding the premises or events, and each of them, their officers and employees, all of which are referred to as "Releasees".
5. I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND DISCHARGE, ALL OF THE RELEASEES FROM ALL LIABILITY TO ME, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, for any and all loss or damage and any claim or any demand on account of any injury to me including, but not limited to, my death, whether caused by the NEGLIGENCE of the Releasees or otherwise.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, UNDERSTAND WHAT I HAVE READ, AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY.

Zero Tolerance Policy



Welcome to the Music City Quarter Midget Racing Association! We are very proud of our facility, race track, club officials, members, and our "Family" atmosphere. To ensure that your family's experience here is a positive one, we have instituted a "Zero Tolerance" Policy. Please review the violations below and make sure that EVERYONE associated with your race team is familiar with them. This Policy will be strictly enforced and all decisions will be made by the MCQMRA Board of Directors. An appeal committee will be set up by the Board of Directors. This committee will consist of 3 MCQMRA club members (in good standing with the club), a race day official, and a BOD member.

1	Deliberately Damaging, Destroying or Defacing MCQMRA Property and Facility	Minimum (1) Year Plus Cost of Damages
2	Being Under the Influence of Drugs or Alcohol During Racing Conditions	Minimum (6) Months - 180 Days
3	Making Any Type of Verbal or Physical Threat to any Person at the MCQMRA Facility (Including Drivers)	Minimum (1) Month - 30 Days
4	Throwing Object in Pit Area or Hot Chute	Minimum (2) Race Weekend
5	Ignoring Instructions From a Track Official	Minimum (1) Race Weekend
6	Violating MCQMRA Rules and Regulations - Including, but not limited to, Smoking in Non-Designated Areas, Violating MCQMRA Practice Policy and Cleaning Tires without Discarding Debris.	Minimum (1) Race Weekend
7	Excessive Yelling, Comments or Obscenities directed at a Track Official, Handler, or Driver.	Minimum (1) Race Weekend
8	Driver Deliberately Hitting Another Driver While on the Race Track or in the Hot Chute.	Done for the Day & DQ from Class (Note: Driver Only)
9	Driver Making a Hand Gesture to Track Official	Done for the Day & DQ from Class (Note: Driver Only)

* Suspension Terms

- All Suspensions are for the **ENTIRE Race Team** (unless noted).
- All Driver Suspensions are for the individual Driver only.
- All Suspension Terms begin the following race date on the Schedule or as noted above.
- All Suspensions will be approved by the Board of Directors in attendance of the race event.
- Suspension Term will be determined by the Board Members in attendance on the date of violation.
- Suspension Term can carry over to the next calendar year.
- Multiple violations/actions within a 12 month period will receive a suspension term.
- All Suspension Terms may be adjusted due to the severity of the violation by the Board of Directors.
- Written notification of Suspension term will be sent, postmarked within 10 days of violation.
- Appeals must be received in writing within 5 days of receiving written suspension notification.

MCQMRA Social Media Policy

Team Name _____

This policy governs the publication of and commentary on social media by members of Music City Quarter Midget Racing Association (MCQMRA). For the purposes of this policy, social media means any facility for online publication and commentary, including without limitation blogs, social networking sites such as Facebook, Twitter, Flickr, and YouTube. This policy is in addition to and complements any existing or future policies regarding the use of technology, computers, e-mail and the internet.

MCQMRA members are free to publish or comment via social media in accordance with this policy. MCQMRA members are subject to this policy to the extent they identify themselves as a MCQMRA member.

Notwithstanding the previous section, this policy applies to all uses of social media, including personal, by MCQMRA members who are drivers, handlers, family members and otherwise related to the racing team, as their position with MCQMRA would be well known within the community.

Setting up Social Media

Social media accounts directly related to MCQMRA are to be set up and managed only by member(s) appointed by the MCQMRA Board of Directors. Any social media set up by someone other than this appointed member is subject to removal and consequences set forth by the MCQMRA Board.

Respect MCQMRA, Members, Drivers, & Other Participants

What you publish will be around for a long time, so consider the content carefully and also be cautious about disclosing any information or comments.

The public in general, and MCQMRA's members and participants, reflect a diverse set of customs, values and points of view. Do be open and honest, but do so respectfully. This includes not only the obvious (no ethnic slurs, offensive comments, defamatory comments, personal insults, obscenity, etc.) but also proper consideration of privacy and of topics that may be considered objectionable or inflammatory. **Absolutely no profanity will be allowed.**

With specific note to the *MCQMRA Members Only* Facebook group, remember that though the intent is for adults only, several drivers and other participants often see or otherwise obtain access to the content of this group and the discussions. Assume that every post, comment and photo will be seen by one of the MCQMRA kids. **Absolutely no use of derogatory language toward MCQMRA club as a whole or any member, driver or other participant is allowed.**

Controversial Issues

If you see misrepresentations made about MCQMRA, its members and/or participants in any media format, you may point that out. Always do so with respect and with the facts. If you speak about others, make sure what you say is factual and that it does not disparage that party. Avoid arguments. Brawls may earn traffic, but nobody wins in the end. Don't try to settle scores or goad competitors or others into inflammatory debates. Make sure what you are saying is factually correct.

Social Media Tips

The best way to be interesting, stay out of trouble, and have fun is to write about what you know - be factual, not assumptive.

Quality matters. Use a spell-checker and proper language.

The speed of being able to publish your thoughts is both a great feature and a great downfall. If in doubt over a post, or if something does not feel right, either let it sit and look at it again before publishing it, or ask someone else to look at it first.

Enforcement

Questionable content is subject to immediate removal by the website or social media moderator/admin and potential violations will be reviewed by MCQMRA Board members who will then determine whether penalties, if any, will be enforced. Penalties for violations are as follows:

1st Offense - Warning

2nd Offense - One (1) Race Suspension

3rd Offense - Banned Until Further Notice
